

Students wishing to ride their bicycles to and from school must inform the Deputy Principal – Student Wellbeing & Operations and must abide by the stipulations outlined in the School’s Riding or Driving to School Policy.

Students are permitted to ride their bicycle to school under the following stipulations:

- Children under the age of 12 may ride on footpaths, as can a supervising adult. They are required to give way to pedestrians and to wheel their bicycles over pedestrian and children’s crossings.

Children aged 12 years or older are required by law to ride on the road.

- Road safety authorities recommend that children under the age of 9 are supervised by an adult when riding on the road. Depending on their cycling skills and experience, some children over this
