## 6. Extra - Curricular Activities

When attending or participating in school activities, Members of the School Community are expected to support the following principles:

- x Accept that students are involved in school activities primarily for their enjoyment and therefore reinforce a healthy attitude towards winning and losing by demonstrating a controlled and disciplined approach to competition.
- x Students learn best by example. Encourage students to play by the rules, behave appropriately and applaud the opposing team at the end of each activity;
- x Behave respectfully and courteously towards players, coaches and officials, showing respect for the rules and authority by word and example (avoid ridicule or chastising a student for making a mistake, losing a game or failing to achieve a certain level);
- x Assist and encourage students to work towards skill improvement and good sportsmanship.
- x The referee or official's judgement or honesty must not be questioned in a confrontational manner in front of other people;
- x Recognise the value of volunteers, including coaches, managers and officials, as they give their time and resources to provide recreational activities for all students.

## 7. Breaches of This Code of Conduct

The consequences to a member of the School Community for breaching this Code of Conduct will be determined at the Principal's absolute discretion and may result in the Member/s of the School Community being:

- x Banned from attending any extra-curricular activity;
- x Banned from being on the School grounds in general;
- x Directed to restrict communications with members of the teaching staff through a nominated School representative;
- x In the case of extreme or prolonged breach of this Code of Conduct by a 0
